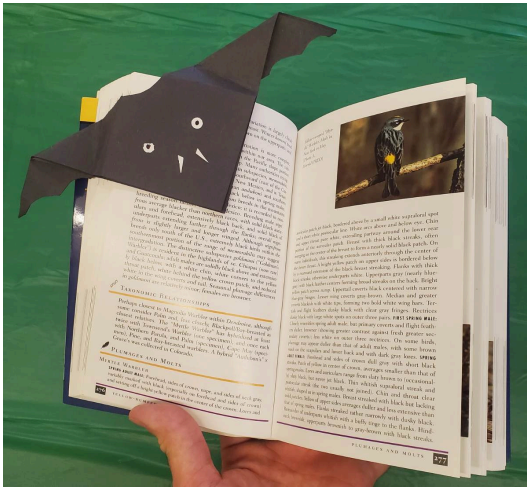
As an addition to our Creepy Creatures event, we will also have a special "Going Batty" program in the evening.
