The Southern Steelhead (*Oncorhynchus mykiss irideus*) is an endangered species that can be found in the lower Santa Ynez River. They once spawned in great abundance in the upper Santa Ynez River before Bradbury Dam was built. They are a distinct population segment of rainbow trout, but they behave like salmon. Instead of spending their whole lives in freshwater, they migrate to the ocean where they change color and grow much larger.
